WES WELKER FOUNDATION GRANT GUIDELINES

LOCATED WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF OKLAHOMA CITY OR A SCHOOL IN THE OKLAHOMA CITY PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT

GRANTEE MUST BE AN EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION OR AN ORGANIZATION THAT IS TAX EXEMPT UNDER SECTION 501 (C)(3) OF THE TAX CODE

MUST SERVE HIGH SCHOOL AGE YOUTH AND/OR YOUNGER; PRIORITY WILL BE GIVEN TO HIGH SCHOOL AND MIDDLE SCHOOL PROGRAMS AND ORGANIZATIONS

ITEMS CONSIDERED BY THE FOUNDATION, IN EVALUATING REQUESTS:

ECONOMICALLY DISADVANTAGED PERCENTAGE
